Dr. Andrew Fenton is a board-certified emergency physician with Napa Valley Emergency Medical Group, and began at Sonoma Valley Hospital 2023. He is the Immediate Past Chief of Staff at the Queen of the Valley Medical Center in Napa and serves on the Medical Staff Executive Committee.

After years as a high school biology teacher, he attended medical school, graduating with honors from George Washington University School of Medicine. He then completed his residency training at UC Davis Medical Center where he received the department's Outstanding Teaching Award. He went on to a fellowship in health policy and legislative advocacy.
