Cherie Hughes and husband, Keith, are co-owners of Hughes Family Vineyards, an award winning artisan winery with organic vineyards in Glen Ellen. Prior to returning to California in 2001, Dr. Hughes was a clinical psychologist who specialized in working with children, adolescents, and their families in her private practice and at Children’s Medical Center hospital in Dallas, Texas. With expertise in assessing neuropsychological disorders and treating problems associated with stress, she was also a consultant to schools where she developed a school suicide and violence prevention program. Dr. Hughes earned her doctorate in Psychology from Southern Methodist University and holds master’s degrees from Northwestern University and from SMU.

Dr. Hughes serves on the Board of Directors for the Sonoma Valley Mentoring Alliance where she served as President, chairs the Advisory Board for Mentoring, and is a founding member of Impact 100 Sonoma. She has also been a member of the Board of the Sonoma Valley Museum of Art and remains active on committees there.
